The Introduction to Photodermatology, with Photophysics & Diagnostics, and Clinical Diagnosis course is scheduled to be held in the Photobiology Unit, Ninewells Hospital in Dundee from Monday 26th April – 30th April 2027.

This educational course alternates annually between the Photobiology Unit in Dundee and the St John's Institute of Dermatology in London. This course is aimed at dermatology trainees and consultants and covers all aspects of photodermatology. The basics of photobiology and photophysics, the photosensitivity diseases, investigation and management will be thoroughly covered. Phototherapeutics, photodynamic therapy and lasers are also included in detail.

The course includes a balanced mix of lectures, practical demonstrations and clinical cases and comprehensively covers photodermatology curriculum requirements and those of a consultant dermatologist. A wide range of speakers with expertise across all areas of photodermatology will participate in the programme.
